A qualified household can receive up to \$25,000 in assistance from the program. A qualified household has an annual gross income of less than 100% of the median income based on household size.)
Mid-Iowa Community Action Inc.	MICA's mission is to provide opportunities to people in vulnerable situations. They equip individuals to achieve stability, security, and success. They collaborate with families and partners to create communities where fewer people find themselves in poverty, and those who do not have a path out.
