

Welcome to Barcelona, a city full of life, color, and history! Upon arrival, we will embark on a captivating walking tour, starting at the towering Columbus Monument near the waterfront, which offers panoramic views of the city and the Mediterranean. Stroll through the lively streets to the Cathedral of Barcelona, a breathtaking Gothic masterpiece with intricate details and serene cloisters, before continuing to the historic Kings Square, where medieval buildings surround a peaceful courtyard. Wander through the vibrant Born District, brimming with boutique shops and charming cafés, and marvel at the stunning Basilica of Santa Maria del Mar, a Gothic gem known for its striking architecture and tranquil atmosphere. Our tour continues to the Picasso Museum, housed in a series of beautifully restored medieval palaces in El Born, where over 4,000 works showcase the early genius of one of the twentieth century's most influential artists. After time for lunch on your own, board the Teleférico de Montjuïc cable car for a breathtaking ride above the city, taking in panoramic views as you ascend to the historic Montjuïc Hill. Stroll through its scenic gardens or visit the Museum of Catalan Art before witnessing the Magic Fountain, a breathtaking spectacle of water, light, and music. We'll end our day with dinner on our own.

#### DAY 4 WEDNESDAY, APRIL 15 **BARCELONA, SPAIN**

Today, our exploration brings us to the imaginative creations of Antoni Gaudí, starting with the vibrant Park Güell, perched on a hill north of Barcelona. This UNESCO World Heritage site blends natural beauty and surreal architecture with colorful mosaics, curving stone pathways, and the iconic serpentine bench. Marvel at the dragon-shaped fountain and enjoy panoramic views of the city and the Mediterranean. Next, visit the aweinspiring Basilica de la Sagrada Familia. With an extensive network of extraordinary pillars soaring toward the ceiling to create a massive image of a tree, windows that give the effect of filtered sunlight through forest branches, swelling spires, and minimal use of straight lines, there is an undeniable fascination with this masterpiece! We end the day at Casa Batlló, a modernist marvel on Passeig de Gràcia, with its dragon-inspired facade and whimsical interior. Enjoy the remainder of the evening free to explore Barcelona at your leisure.

### DAY 11 WEDNESDAY, APRIL 22 LISBON, PORTUGAL (B, D)

An exciting day of touring awaits us today in Lisbon. Our first stop is **Belém Tower**, a striking sixteenth-century fortress on the Tagus River that once guarded Lisbon's harbor. Now a UNESCO World Heritage site, it offers breathtaking waterfront views and a glimpse into Portugal's seafaring past. Next is the **Monument to the Navigators**, an iconic tribute to Portugal's Age of Exploration, adorned with statues of legendary explorers and intricate bas-reliefs.
