Wed, Jun-01 DINGLE PENINSULA

Today, discover the Dingle Peninsula, described by National Geographic as "the most beautiful place on earth." Then visit Dingle Distillery, which puts a distinctive Irish twist to their whiskey, gin and vodka. After some time to stroll and explore Dingle village, travel back towards Killarney for dinner at the family-owned Foley's Bar in the village of Inch. OVERNIGHT: EUROPE HOTEL & RESORT, KILLARNEY

Thu, Jun-02 JAUNTING CAR RIDE & RING OF KERRY

This morning begins with a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through the grounds of the Killarney National Park. Then board the coach and drive through magical scenery to the village of Kenmare. Visit Brendan Ferris' Farm, to see some sheepdogs working in their natural environment. Tonight's dinner is hosted at the Killeen House, named top fine dining restaurant in Ireland by Trip Advisor in 2021. OVERNIGHT: EUROPE HOTEL & RESORT

Fri, Jun-03 CLIFFS OF MOHER & GALWAY

Leaving Killarney, travel north through County Limerick and into County Clare to view the stunning Cliffs of Moher, which stretch 5 miles along the wild Atlantic Ocean. Sat, Jun-04 QUIET MAN WALKING TOUR

After breakfast, travel north into County Mayo and the village of Cong which was made famous by the 1952 movie "The Quiet Man" featuring John Wayne and Maureen O'Hara.
